



Covid-19 Case Response Management

Competition owners, participants and spectators all have a role to play in ensuring that netball can be resumed in a safe, controlled and successful manner in a Covid-19 environment. The following conditions of resumption relate to Case Response Management.

Incident Management

- Where an individual is suspected to have Covid-19, the Club and Competition Owner must;
 - Isolate the individual.
 - Isolate the area/s recently occupied by the individual.
 - Help the individual seek treatment.
 - Responsibly discard any items used to treat the individual.
 - Ask those who treated the individual to immediately self-isolate.

Cleaning

- Any area which the effected individual has been in contact with or occupied must be thoroughly cleaned with disinfectant.
- Any items used for cleaning should be responsibly discarded.
- Personal protective equipment including face masks, eyewear and gloves should be used when cleaning.
- Consideration should be given to outsourcing to a professional cleaning service.

Reporting

- Competition owners must advise Netball Tasmania upon confirmation of a Covid-19 case in the Netball community.
- Netball Tasmania will advise public health authorities and obtain direction.
- Netball activity in the applicable Club and Competition should be suspended until direction provided.
- Netball Tasmania and the Competition Owner to work together to identify recent close contacts within the netball community and advise them to monitor health and recommend self-isolation for 14 days.
- Competition Owners must assist Public Health authorities with any process relating to tracing of contact, and potential quarantine or a venue or participants.

Re-opening / Recommencing

- Venues should seek advice and approval from public health authorities prior to reopening post a confirmed case of Covid-19.
- Any individuals in close contact with the infected person should provide a medical clearance prior to returning to a netball environment.
