Resumption of Netball in a Covid-19 Environment

# Venue Management

Competition owners, participants and spectators all have a role to play in ensuring that netball can be resumed in a safe, controlled and successful manner in a Covid-19 environment. The following conditions of resumption relate to Venue Management.

# Cleaning and Hygiene

- Strict cleaning protocols must be implemented to ensure that surfaces such as door handles, railings and benchtops are being regularly cleaned with disinfectant. Schedules must be displayed and signed off as completed.
- Toilets are to be cleaned daily, and soap dispensers must be present and filled regularly.
- Hand sanitiser stations to be placed at each entry and throughout the venue, particularly in high traffic areas, and refilled regularly.
- Rubbish bins to throughout the venue and emptied regularly.

### Canteen

- Canteen Managers are to familiarise themselves with health standards relating to food and beverage service in a Covid-19 environment.
- All food and beverage service must be 'take away' only. No tables should be provided for the consumption of food, for the avoidance of gatherings.
- Canteens to create marked and controlled queuing areas to avoid gatherings and allow compliance with the 1.5m physical distancing standard.
- Cash-free payment systems must be used to avoid cash handling by attendees and staff.
- Vending machine surfaces should be cleaned regularly.

### **Spectator Management**

- Notice must be posted at the venue entry advising that anyone unwell may not enter.
- Mechanisms to be implemented to count, monitor and control the number of individuals present in a venue, or designated area of a venue, in order to adhere to applicable public health guidelines.
- Restrictions to be implemented on the number of individuals using communal facilities, to ensure that physical distancing standards of 1.5m are achieved.
- Doors are to remain open where possible to allow ventilation and entry/exit without touching he handle or door surface.

# Scheduling

 Training bookings are to be scheduled in a staggered fashion to manage/minimise the traffic flow through the venue at any point in time and create greater capacity for physical distancing.

### Education

 Visual cues such as posters and floor stickers are to be placed throughout venues to educate and remind attendees of expected health and hygiene related behaviour.
