

Management Plan

Resumption of Netball in a Covid-19 Environment

Return to Play – Stage 3

From 12pm on 26 June 2020

The following conditions will apply to Stage 3 of Netball recommencement in Tasmania, applicable from June 26th 2020.

Training

- Limited to a total of 50 participants per court including athletes and team officials. •
- Contesting and contact drills, as well as match-play, is now permitted. •
- Trainings are no longer restricted to 60 minutes (no limit time limit applied). •
- Change rooms may not be accessible at venue discretion. •
- Netball Tasmania's Venue and Training Management Plans for Resumption of Netball in a Covid-19 Environment must be adhered to.

Community Competition Resumption

Community Netball may now resume.

Please note - Netball Tasmania supports local Association decision making relating to appropriate resumption dates to ensure that Associations have time to prepare to adequately meet health and safety requirements.

- Netball Tasmania's Venue and Competition Management Plans for Resumption of Netball in a Covid-19 Environment must be adhered to.
- The maximum number of attendees allowable in a venue in total will be dictated by the • local Association. This will be based on;
 - A total outdoor capacity of no more than 500 persons per undivided area; and
 - A total indoor capacity of 250 persons per undivided area, or one person per 2 square metres, whichever is less.



















- In order to adhere to maximum attendee restrictions, Associations are encouraged to set a maximum 'per participant' cap on spectators.
- Change rooms may not be accessible at venue discretion.

RACT Insurance Tasmanian Netball League Resumption

- The RACT Insurance Tasmanian Netball League will recommence on Friday 24 July 2020.
- The revised roster will run for 10 weeks including finals, with the Grand Final set to be played 3 October.
- Netball Tasmania's Venue and Competition Management Plans for Resumption of Netball in a Covid-19 Environment must be adhered to.
- The maximum number of attendees allowable at a match will be determined by capacity restrictions imposed on the applicable venues as follows;
 - Kingborough Stadium 250 total participants per 'stadium'
 - o Hobart Netball and Sports Centre 250 total participants per 'stadium'
 - Silverdome 250 total participants in the playing arena (which may at times see two matches being played concurrently).
 - Ulverstone Stadium 250 total participants per match.
 - St Brendan Shaw College 250 total participants per match.
- In order to adhere to total attendee limits, clubs will be advised by Netball Tasmania of a 'per participant' cap on spectators applicable to each venue and round.
- Change rooms may not be accessible at venue discretion.
