Responsibilities Assist the Head Coach and other support staff to prepare the state team to compete in the National Championships Manage travel, accommodation, meals and well-being of the athletes and support staff Prepare and distribute daily schedules for travel, training, meals, competition and meetings. Ensure that all athletes and support staff are aware of the schedule Ensure athletes are provided with appropriate food and beverages during training, travel, pre and post competition and on recovery days during competition Liaise with the relevant local organizing authorities as required Ensure that athletes and support staff complete applicable education and support athletes with any drug testing requirements Manage applicable competition and match-day paperwork as required Liaising with match/bench managers and venue staff and ensure that coaches and athletes are made aware of match day operations In conjunction with other team staff, ensure that all staff and athletes are well presented in applicable uniform and conducting themselves in a manner consistent with Netball Tasmania's culture and standards Develop an open and trusting relationship with Coaches and Team Staff to ensure that everyone's role is understood and everyone knows what the other staff require of them Attend all team training sessions, camps and meetings, including team selections if required by the Head Coach or otherwise agreed to Liaise with Primary Carer, Head Coach and athletes to roster any medical/recovery appointments during competition Liaise with Performance Pathway Manager to ensure all essential equipment and uniforms are ordered Provide a post-event report to the Performance Pathway Manager Participate in the evaluation process post-event
