



Member Registration Fees 2026

Netball Tasmania Membership enables Members to participate in any competition run by an affiliated Association. All participants in affiliated Association competitions must have a Membership prior to competing. The registration process will prompt the purchase of an applicable Netball Tasmania Membership.

2026 Member Registration Fees

- **Senior Participant 12 month PlayHQ) \$78.52 plus GST and Transaction Fee (\$88.13 in PlayHQ)**
Senior participants are classified as individuals turning 18 years or older during the year of competition.
- **Junior Participant 12 month PlayHQ) \$64.58 plus GST and Transaction Fee (\$72.49 in PlayHQ)**
Junior participants are classified as individuals turning 17 years or younger during the year of competition.
- **Non-Player Membership (Official, Coach) \$39.02 plus GST and Transaction Fee (\$43.80 in PlayHQ)**
Anyone serving as an Official or Coach who also participates as a player in a competition must register in the player role and their secondary membership fee will be discounted based on the overlap of periods across their playing and non-playing roles.
Officials includes Umpires and Primary Carers.
- **Non- Player (Team Manager, Volunteer) \$0**
Team Managers and Volunteers such as Bench Officials and Committee Members will be required to register as a Volunteer in the registration system and will be deemed as Financial Members, with no charge applicable to these roles.
- **Woolworths Net Set Go (12 mths) \$64.58 plus GST and Transaction Fee (\$72.49 in PlayHQ)**
This membership fee is made up of Netball Tasmania's Net Set Go Woolworth membership fee of \$28.23 plus GST, combined with a fee of \$36.35 plus GST set by Netball Australia to cover the Woolworths Net Set Go participant pack.



2026 Netball Australia – Annual Digital Systems and Services Fee

Netball Australia charge an annual fee (players only) which contributes to the upkeep of digital systems and services (such as Service & Support). In 2026 this fee will be priced at **\$5.00** plus GST and Transaction Fee (**\$5.61**), charged on an annual basis through the registration process.

Social (3 Month) Membership

To account for rosters which run for less than 3 months in total, Senior and Junior participants will have the option to select a 3 Month Membership, which will be offered at a **50% discount** to the full-year Member Registration Fees.

If the individual participates in any subsequent competition during the year, they will be required to purchase another membership to cover the period of the additional competition(s).

Payment of Member Fees

Participants pay their Netball Tasmania Member Registration Fees directly to Netball Tasmania through online self-registration, via the registration platform PlayHQ. At the conclusion of the registration process, participants see a payment breakdown similar to that listed below;
